



A Quick Guide to Finding Evidence-based Medical Information

STEP	ACTION
1	<p>PubMed: Search for systematic reviews</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Go to PubMed: http://www.pubmed.gov 2) Select “Clinical Queries” tool on the far left menu 3) Select “Systematic Reviews” 4) Enter keyword(s) and click on “Go”
2	<p>PubMed: Search for randomized controlled trials</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Go to PubMed: http://www.pubmed.gov 2) Select “Clinical Queries” tool on the far left menu 3) Select “Clinical Queries using Research Methodology Filters” 4) Enter keyword(s) and click on “Go”
3	<p>OVID: Search the Cochrane Library & the Database of Abstracts of Reviews of Effectiveness (DARE):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Cochrane Library includes a database of systematic reviews (all referenced in PubMed) as well as DARE, a database of synopses of published systematic reviews. • Cochrane also includes a list of reviews in progress (Protocols) and a registry of Clinical Trials (The Cochrane Central Register of Controlled Trials). <p>Cochrane Library is free to AZHIN:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Go to http://www.azhin.org 2) Click MEDLINE 3) [Start OVID] 4) Select “All EBM Reviews” (or database of your choice) 5) Enter keyword(s) and click on “Perform Search”
